How does Fundscrip work?

All you have to do is buy gift cards and gift certificates from Fundscrip for the stores where you already shop. It couldn't be easier because you are earning money on things you are already going to buy.

The gift certificates come in two forms, paper and plastic. When using the traditional paper certificate as payment for an amount less than the face value, the retailer will provide you with change or will provide you with a store credit. Each time you use the plastic card, the value of the purchase is automatically deducted from the value stored on the card. Any remaining balance can be used for future purchases.

Tell me more about how I can reduce my hockey fees!

30% the money each family raises through Fundscrip will be helping the North River Minor Hockey Association and Communities 13 Inc to help offset the need for future fee increases and provide for rink projects that benefit minor hockey. **The other 70%** will be available to you for minor hockey registration fees...that's right the money comes right off your registration. We had families for 2009-10 that received over \$300 off their minor hockey registrations.

An average family will earn about **\$400 in FREE MONEY** using this program. That would mean you could have \$280 credited towards your hockey fees. And remember, **it doesn't cost you anything extra!**

How to get started

- Create your fundscrip account
- Start raising money towards your registration

Method of Payment

- You can pay for your purchases by Electronic Funds Transfer (**EFT**)
- EFT is the easiest way to pay for your order each week via your computer.
- Fundscrip submits a debit to your bank account and then your financial institution transfers the money electronically.
- It is also very secure as your banking information is never stored online.
- You will receive a confirmation by email when your account is activated.

To be able to pay by EFT, you must fill out form available online and fax to Fundscrip

How to order

- Go to www.fundscrip.com & click on 'Login' at the bottom of the screen
- Enter your email address and password
- Click on "Place Your Order"
- Place your order and click "Next"
- NRMHA will be ordering every two weeks and weekly starting the middle of November
- Your order must be in before 10:15 am local time on Thursday (of your delivery week) for delivery of gift cards on Tuesday evening at the Canteen at the APM Center (except weeks with Holidays). Orders can be picked up Tuesday and Wednesday evenings and weekdays at the APM Center.
